Form B - Non-Pennsylvania Resident - Volunteer Affirmation

A volunteer who is not a resident of Pennsylvania but is volunteering at an official MAR Event located in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania is required to do one of the following: (1) complete a form affirming he/she is in compliance with the laws in their domiciled (home) state, if any, that govern people who work or volunteer with children; (2) provide a copy of clearance forms he/she may already have obtained from their domiciled (home) state indicating that he/she are in compliance with the laws governing individuals who work or volunteer with children in that state; or (3) complete the three clearances as required under Pennsylvania Act 153.

Under penalty of law, I affirm that I am not a resident of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. I am aware that *FIRST* Mid-Atlantic will be relying upon this Volunteer Affirmation for the purpose of complying with Pennsylvania's Child Protective Services Law ("CPSL"), Act 153.

I further affirm that in the event that I am arrested for, or convicted of, an offense that would constitute grounds for denying my further participation as a volunteer, or if I am named as a perpetrator of child abuse, I will immediately provide *FIRST* Mid-Atlantic with written notice of the arrest, conviction or notification that I have been listed as a perpetrator of child abuse. I acknowledge that providing false information and/or willfully failing to disclose information as required by law constitutes a crime.
